Re: Director's Report- December 2021 Program Report

Updates from Office of Head Start:

- OHS Vaccine Mandate: Effective January 31, 2022, all Head Start employees, volunteers, consultants, therapists having contact with children will be required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. The program has already been in contact with our community partners regarding this new mandate. Therapists who choose not be vaccinated will arrange to complete the child's therapy in the home.
- OHS Tracking Programs for Full Funded Enrollment PAUSED: OHS will not resume evaluating which
 programs will enter into the Full Enrollment Initiative beginning in January 2022, as previously
 communicated. OHS will, however, continue to track enrollment, as OHS has done since September 2021.
 Additionally, OHS will continue to expect full in-person comprehensive services to be provided contingent
 upon CDC guidelines, state and local health department guidelines, and in consideration of local school
 districts' decisions.
- Year 3 Grant Application was Submitted on 12/21/21

Program Updates

- Hiring: Interviews are ongoing for all open positions.
 - Assistant Director of Education and Center-based Services: Will post
 - 3 Lead Teacher vacancies: -1 HS- Cambridge, 1 HS- Granville, 1 EHS- Whitehall
 - 2 Assistant Teacher: 1 EHS- Cambridge; 1 HS- Dix
 - o 1 Teacher Aide positions: 1 HS- Cambridge; 1-Transportation Aide/Bus Aide- Whitehall
 - 2 Home-based Visitors
- **COVID:** We are seeing an uptick in positive children and family members exposed in the community or at home. We are continuing to follow protocols; classrooms are closed when mandatory quarantining is required.
 - All Staff are fully vaccinated with the exception of 5 who applied for exemption.
- Buildings and Grounds: Funded through American Rescue Plan funds.
 - Security System Upgrades: All centers with the exception of Granville have had an upgrade to their security system and panic buttons installed. These upgrades were as a result of guidance received by Washington County Sheriff and Washington County Public Health.
 - New Furnace and AC Units Cambridge

- **Training:** Program Supervisors are participating in monthly team supervisory support and training sessions. The goal is to build supervisory skills and develop a consistent approach to implementing policy and providing staff professional development.
